There are several locations you can purchase Emergency kits from. They pack them in many different types of containers too, from backpacks, fanny packs and even in plastic buckets with lids. It all depends on what you would like to have and where you are planning to store it. A good location is the back of your car, as your car is generally wherever you are. In addition to these kits, we recommend several cases of water stored in the corner of your garage. We encourage you to actually use the water and replace it as you use it. We would recommend a stock pile of 5 cases of water. Water is inexpensive from Costco or Sam's, about \$4 a case. If you need some help, just ask, we will help.
